I. Call to order:

II. Coaches report/comments

1. Next year's Summer Camp: Coach would like to have a flyer out for the 2012 summer camp by the end of this month. The camp will be for squirts through high school. There was discussion regarding having a committee for this or having one person coordinating the camp. Scott recommended that they have a separate meeting with Coach, the girls hockey coach, Scott and maybe Jim to work out some of the details on the camp.
2. Coach mentioned that he has signed up for a tournament in Roseau for next year for JV and Varsity. This will replace the Schwan's Cup tournament and will be approximately December 27th to 29th. The Roseau tournament will pay for 6 hotel rooms for 2 nights. Coach will have more complete details in the next week or two.

III: Budget report/Update: Jim reported that the bake sale brought in a profit of \$236.75, the raffle tickets brought in a profit of \$3900 and the old jerseys sold brought in \$470. Revenue for the year is \$48000 and the expenses are \$44400 so the balance as of right now in the account is about \$3500.

IV: OLD BUSINESS:

- a. **Skate with the Cardinals & Youth Day:** Skate with the Cardinals will be on Saturday, January 21st vs. Irondale. Scott is getting details organized with the youth. Flyers are now posted in the arena.
- b. **Feed My Starving Children:** This will be held on January 16th from 12:00 to 2:00. Practice is in the morning and then breakfast will be served after practice. Becky mentioned that FMSC asked to bring a donation to help pay for the food. \$32 was collected at the January 7th game and we will try to collect more. Coach will also be going to FMSC and will make sure the players know it is mandatory to attend.
- c. **Senior Recognition Day:** Becky reported that the committee has already started the planning. One resurface will be eliminated during the JV game to allow for time. Recognition ceremony will start between 2:20 and 2:30.
- d. **End of Year Banquet:** Avis Braschayko and John Lundberg are the Chair/Co-Chair for this and have been in contact with Greenhaven and Harvest Grill and both have March 18th available. John has sent emails to Harvest Grill and they have not responded his emails regarding prices for food. He will try emailing them again and will send a copy of the email to John Nash who is the Manager at Harvest Grill. The cost of a buffet at Greenhaven is \$17.50 per person.

Gift cards will be given to the managers and coaches.

Orange Lily placed an ad in the program this year and also donated \$125 for flowers. Becky will use a portion for the mom's at Senior Recognition Day and the rest will be used for the end of the year banquet.

Scott will send out an email to all the parents to save the date of March 18th for the end of year banquet. Final invitations will be sent out when a decision is made as to where the banquet will be and how much advance notice for number of people the venue will need. Steve mentioned that maybe the school can print out the invitations for a cheaper price.

Scott will purchase the end of year awards once he gets the names from Coach since he did them last year and will be Master of Ceremony.

Next year's Board Members: Steve, Jim, Tammy and Judy will be staying on the board. Scott reported that Denise Roy volunteered to be on the board next year. John Lundberg also stated that he would be on the board. Scott and Jim are talking to some other parents to see if they are interested. If anyone is interested they should talk to Scott. If needed, there will be an election sometime in February and any new board members would start attending board meetings in March. **More involvement is needed from new parents. Especially for next year!**

V. NEW BUSINESS

a. Youth Bake Sale: Scott received an email regarding the youth having a Bake Sale Benefit for Jack Jablonski on Saturday, January 14th and Sunday, January 15th.
